## Second Language Psycholinguistics Lab COVID-19 measures

## March 13, 2020

Effective immediately (Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 10:00 am): do not schedule any <u>new</u> in-person testing visits to the lab until you hear you can do so from me.

## For the visits already scheduled:

- If possible, reschedule the visit
- If you can test remotely, please do so.

## If these two things are not possible:

- Recommend all study subjects to call ahead before coming to the research visit if they have recently (in the past 15 days) traveled to Level 2 or 3 countries, to other states in the US, or are experiencing any cough, fever or cold like symptoms => if so, cancel the visit/reschedule
- If subjects are symptom free and they have not traveled outside of Indiana in the past 15 days, they can come to the lab but you are required to follow this procedure:
  - Practice social distance (do not shake hands, don't get too close while explaining, etc.)
  - Ask subjects to wash hands with water and soap before starting the experiment, and do so yourself (show them the bathroom)
  - Disinfect the touched surfaces (table, mouse, keyboard, the <u>outside</u> of headphones, seat elbow rests etc.) with the provided disinfectant wipes and discard
  - Use new disposable ear-cushion covers provided for the headphones, and discard after the experiment (do not use chemicals on the ear cushion!)
  - After subject leaves, disinfect the surfaces again, and wipe door handles/knobs, light switches, etc.
